



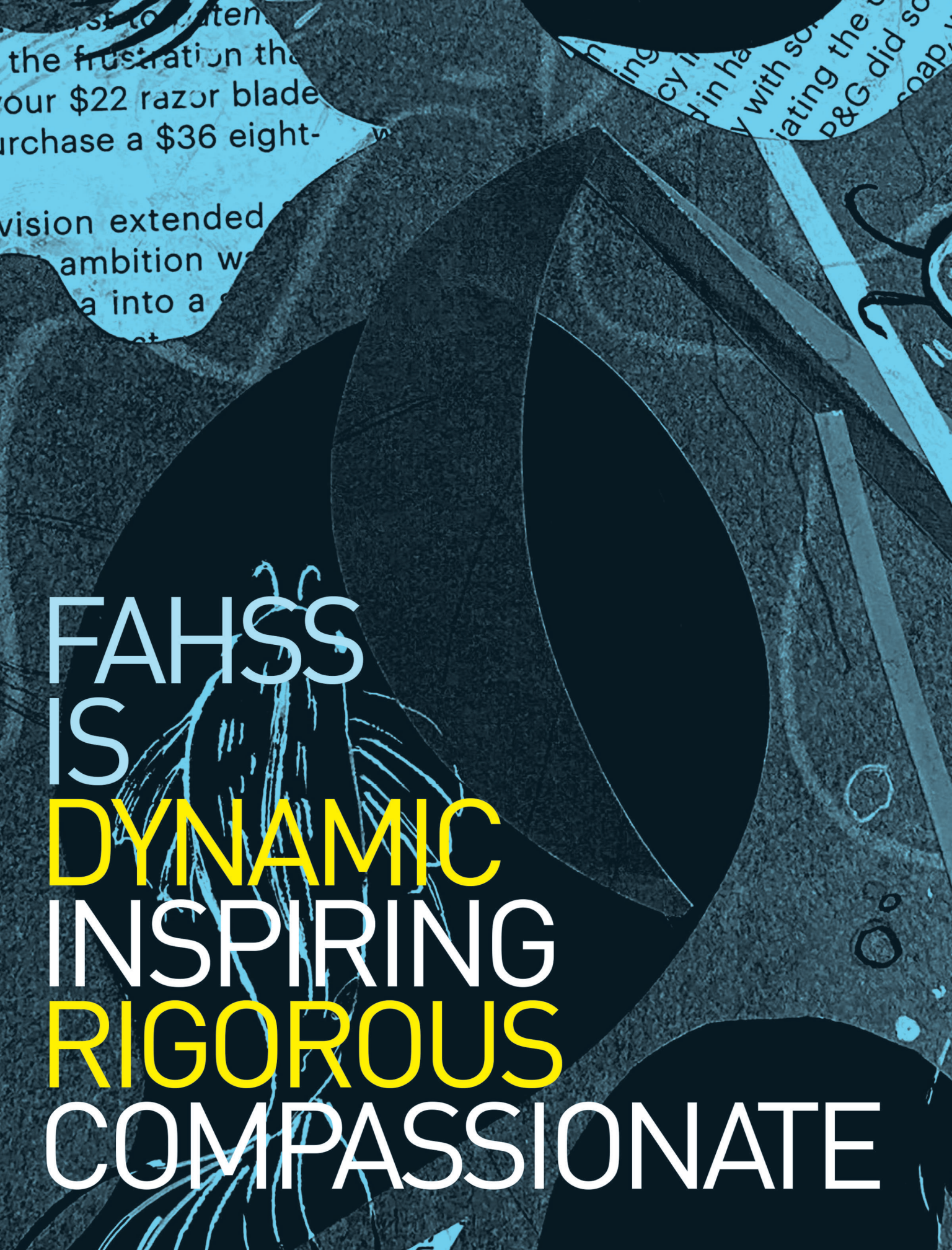

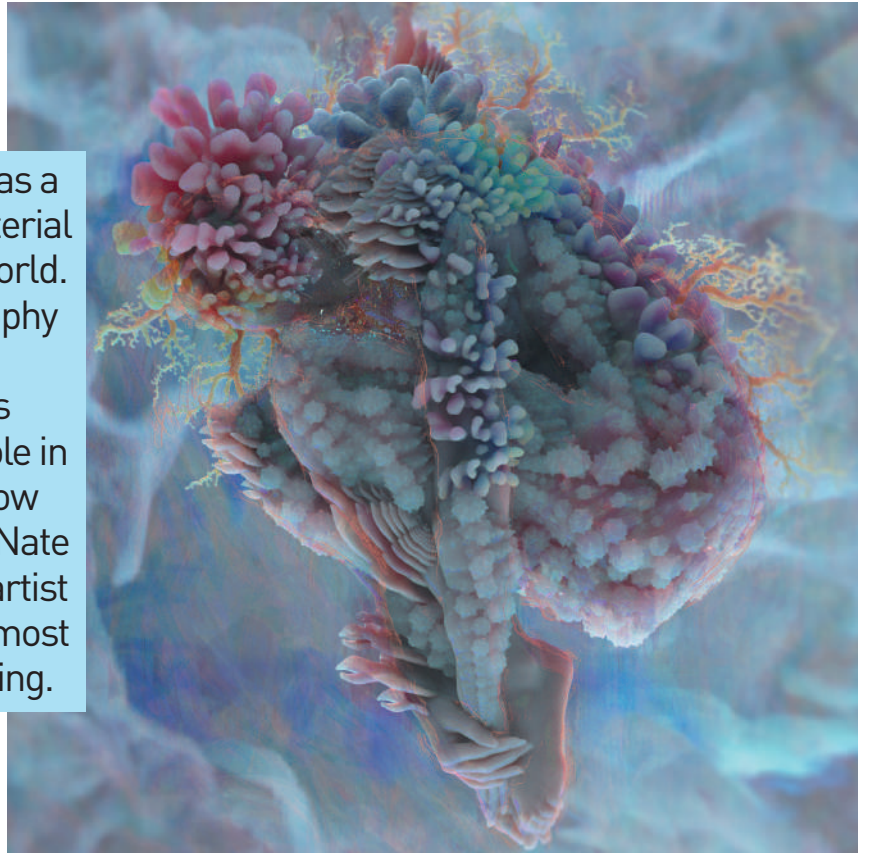
Lifting up students and our community
